### Adrienne Cohen Memorial Funds:

#### Israel fund:

for individuals who have never traveled to Israel.

#### Education Fund :

provides funding for meaningful new formats to encourage students to further their Jewish studies.

Cantor's Discretionary Fund: Fund is used to support musical and cultural programs. Administered and acknowledged by: FVJC-ES Board of Directors.

Cemetery Fund : Monies are used for maintenance, upkeep and improvements to the FVJC-ES Memorial Park.
